Directions:

A. From Hartford-

Rte 2 East towards Norwich to exit 19 (Rte 11).

Take first exit for Lake Hayward.

Take R off exit and follow till the *stop sign.

Take L at stop and follow approx. 2 miles to 1st street on left.

Take L onto East Shore Dr. 1/2-3/4 of a mile, stay right at fork, straight down dirt road in front of you instead of following the main road which goes left.

Go all the way to the end.

B. From Middletown,

Take Rte 66 over the Portland Bridge to

rte 16 east to Colchester, to rte 2 east in Colchester.

Take Right onto Rte 2.

Take exit for Rte. 11,

Take first exit for Lake Hayward.

Take R off exit and follow till the *stop sign.

Take L at stop and follow approx. 2 miles to 1st street on left.

Take L onto East Shore Dr. 1/2-3/4 of a mile, stay right at fork, straight down dirt road in front of you instead of following the main road which goes left.

Go all the way to the end

C. From Boston: Rte 90w to Rte. 395s (below Worcester)

Get onto rte 2 West in Norwich and follow to the Parum Road exit in Colchester.

Take L off the exit and then take you next R. Follow this to 4-way intersection. Continue forward under the highway and continue until you get to the stop sign. Take L at stop and follow approx. 2 miles to 1st street on left.

Take L onto East Shore Dr. 1/2-3/4 of a mile, stay right at fork, straight down dirt road in front of you instead of following the main road which goes left.
